Thank you for your interest in the Virginia Club of New York, in residence at the Yale Club of New York City!

The Virginia Club of New York, informally in existence since the late 1830s, found residence at the Yale Club in the winter of 1994. Since then, UVA alumni have possessed a home away from home, a 22-story clubhouse located on the corner of 44th Street and Vanderbilt Avenue, in the heart of Manhattan and conveniently located next to Grand Central Terminal. The Yale Club is the largest college-affiliated clubhouse in the world, serving nearly 13,000 members with the finest facilities, a friendly and attentive staff, and a sense of camaraderie you won't find anywhere else.

Inside the Clubhouse, you will find:

- 138 comfortably-decorated guest rooms and suites
- A newly-renovated athletic facility consisting of three international squash courts, cardio machines, a weight room, a variety of classes and a pool
- Three dining rooms, a rooftop terrace, and two bars
- Banquet and catering facilities for events from 10 to 300 people
- A 50,000-volume reference library and two workspaces
- A presidential Main Lounge perfect for meeting guests or enjoying a complimentary coffee

Outside of the Club, our members gain access to reciprocal arrangements with over 100 prestigious clubs throughout the world. Other member benefits include access to the Virginia Club and Yale Club's event slate, with offerings spanning from networking opportunities and spirited game watches to unique New York City experiences.

JOINING THE CLUB

Who may join? All UVA graduates (college or graduate school) may join the Club. Graduates of Yale, Dartmouth, and Delta Kappa Epsilon Fraternity (regardless of school) are also able to join the Club. Non-alumni may apply to join as an Associate Member; however, the process is more complex.

Can my spouse/partner join? Yes - members may request membership for their spouse or domestic partner (regardless of school attended) for \$390.03 per year and a one-time \$816.56 spousal initiation fee. This membership gives the spouse or domestic partner a separate account number and access to the Club regardless of whether the member is present. Other family members cannot be added to membership, but are welcome to visit as guests.

How do I join? Contact uvanyc@uvanyc.org or visit our website for the application form. Letters of reference are not required. Prospective members will be contacted to submit a headshot, as well as an initial payment consisting of their first month's dues, first month's UVA assessment fee, first month's capital assessment fee, and initiation fee. After payment submission, memberships will be activated within one week.

BILLING FACTS AND TERMINOLOGY

Yale Club Dues: Monthly dues are based on **undergraduate class year**, regardless of the university attended, and proximity of the applicant's home or work residence to the Club. For example, if the applicant graduated from college in 2012 and then went to UVA for graduate school and graduated in 2015, the applicant would be placed into the 2012 membership category. The address closer to the Clubhouse is used to figure the membership category.

UVA Assessment: This fee goes directly to the Virginia Club of New York.

One-Time Initiation Fee: Equal to twelve months of Yale Club dues.

Capital Commitment Fee: All members are charged \$59.88 per month for the Capital Commitment. The fee supports the maintenance and improvements of the historic Yale Club building. This charge is required.

All rates listed in this packet are inclusive of 8.875% New York State sales tax where applicable.

There is no tipping at the Club. 18% gratuity is added to all food and beverage bills.

Use of the Athletic Facilities is an additional charge and must be opted-in to (see last page of the packet).

Discounts: Class of 2025 undergraduates will receive a waived initiation fee upon their graduation through December 31, 2025. Current full-time graduate students receive a significantly reduced initiation fee, as well as roughly 50% off their respective dues category (see the corresponding dues schedule).

Paying Your Bill: The current month's dues and assessments, along with any house charges from the previous month, are billed on the first of each month. Payment may be made on the Yale Club internal site with a credit card or bank transfer, over the phone, or by check. Autobilling is available. Failure to pay monthly bills will result in a \$25.00 late fee per month and an additional charge of 1.5% of your overdue balance.

USING THE CLUB AND HOUSE RULES

How do I manage my membership and make reservations? Upon membership activation, you will receive credentials for The Yale Club members' website and mobile app. Your digital membership card is found on the app, and you may make reservations, pay bills, and view the calendar of events on the website and app.

Can I bring guests? Members are permitted to bring up to ten guests along with them to use the Club, or to reserve a Guest Pass with the Front Desk for \$15 per day if they will not be physically present. Members can also reserve hotel rooms on behalf of guests, and they will have Clubhouse access for the duration of their stay.

What is the dress code? Business attire or business casual dress is required in all public spaces except for the athletic facilities. Denim – neat, clean, and in good repair – is permitted throughout the Clubhouse. Shorts are permitted from Memorial Day to Labor Day, provided they are not denim or athletic in nature. Athletic shorts are only permitted in the athletic facilities. Non-athletic shoe wear that has a "sneaker-like" sole is permitted throughout the entire Clubhouse. Shoes must be clean and in good repair. Shoes worn for orthopedic purposes are permitted throughout the Clubhouse. Not permitted: Tshirts, tank or midriff tops, casual sandals (such as flip flops, slip-ons, or plastic sandals), white sneakers, high tops or finger toes, capri or cargo pants, athletic wear of any kind (including shorts, sweat pants, leggings, caps, jerseys, and hoodies), and torn or revealing clothing.

Can I bring my kids? Children are welcome in the Club. Children under the age of 12 are exempted from items listed as not permitted, though ripped or torn clothing remains a violation

What are the electronic policies? Cell phones: Ringers must be set to 'silent mode.' Texting or Internet browsing on cell phones is permitted everywhere (except locker rooms). Phone calls are permitted in the Lobby, stairwells, phone booths, guest rooms, and the Grill Room when meals are not being served.

Laptops: Laptops are permitted in the Library, guest rooms, and the Grill Room with the exception of meal service. **Tablets:** Use of iPad, Kindle, and other e-readers is permitted in all public spaces (except locker rooms).

Can I host a meeting or do work in the Club? The Library is open as a silent workspace. Outside of meal service hours, the Grill Room is open as a workspace; hosting meetings (in-person or virtually) is permitted. Members may meet colleagues for networking purposes but cannot display papers or laptops in the Main Lounge, Main Bar, or any of the restaurants. The Yale Club also has a number of private event spaces for corporate events and meetings ranging in size from 10 to 300 hundred attendees. The Clarence Day Room is also available to reserve for private meetings.

Are there food and beverage minimums? No.

What are the hotel rooms like? The Yale Club has 138 overnight rooms, ranging from studio (one twin bed) to king suites. Rates fluctuate based on market demand and the type of room requested. For current rates, email guestrooms@yaleclubnyc.org or call the Front Desk at 212.716.2100. Members may view real-time rates and make reservations on The Yale Club's website and mobile app.

What about reciprocal clubs? Membership includes access to over 100 reciprocal clubs worldwide. For a full list of reciprocal clubs, please visit The Yale Club website or mobile app. Members may request access to a

reciprocal club via The Yale Club website or mobile app. Members are allowed reciprocal visits for no more than two consecutive weeks per quarter.

Will my dues increase in the future? The Yale Club occasionally adjusts dues on a calendar-year basis; the dates found at the top of the dues schedule denote when these listed prices are accurate. Any dues increases will be communicated to members.

What if I need to cancel my membership? Members can resign their membership at any time by emailing the Virginia Club, filling out a resignation form, and paying their current balance. Reinstatement can be done at any time by paying a reinstatement fee.



ATHLETIC FACILITIES

What are the gym hours? Gym, pool, and locker room hours are posted on The Yale Club's Athletics page, www.yaleclubnyc.org/athletics. Generally, the Athletic facilities are open seven days a week, including early morning and evening access.

What is the price of the Athletic Package? The Athletic Package includes access to the gym, group fitness classes, and the pool. Clubhouse members can sign up for the Athletic Package for an additional monthly charge of \$59.85.

What if I only want to use the gym occasionally? Non-Athletic Package holders can use the Athletic facilities and pool for a daily fee of \$20. Overnight guests receive complimentary gym access.

What if I want to enter the Club in athletic attire? The Lobby does not have a dress code – so long as members proceed straight to the athletic facilities, members can enter and exit the Club in athletic attire.

Can I bring guests to the gym? Members may bring guests to the gym for a daily fee (\$20), if the member is present. If the member is not present, members can set up a guest pass through the Front Desk for \$15 and then gym access will be an additional \$20.

Can I bring my kids to the gym? Children 15 and under can only use the squash courts and pool. Children ages 16 and 17 require adult supervision if they use the gym.

What are the details of the squash courts? The Athletic facilities have three international squash courts. Eye protection, court shoes (no black soles), and appropriate athletic attire are required to use the courts.

Courts are \$18 for 45 minutes. Members can book squash courts one week in advance through The Yale Club website or mobile app. One does not need an Athletic Package to reserve a squash court, and the fee applies regardless of Athletic Package status.

Lessons and clinics are available with elite pro squash instructors and associate pro squash instructors. Please call **212.716.2128** for current rates

What are the details of the Locker Rooms? Locker rooms are available for use by all members, regardless of whether they have an Athletic Package. Each locker room has showers, a steam room, and a sauna. Day lockers are available at no cost. Annual lockers are available for \$240.00 and include laundry service. Squash lockers are available for \$95.00 per year. To inquire about lockers, contact the Athletic Department at **212.716.2128**.

Are there any other Athletics offerings? The Yale Club has a robust offering of group fitness classes, including yoga, Zumba, kickboxing, spinning, and more – both in-person and livestreamed. The calendar can be found on the Club website and mobile app. The classes are free of charge to Athletic Package holders.

Swedish, Shiatsu, Therapeutic, Sports, Prenatal, and Deep Tissue massages are available by appointment. We also offer personal training and stretch sessions. Please call **212.716.2128** for current rates.
